Therefore, being active at SCOPE means that you will be part of a pillar that targets students with similar interests as you. Within this pillar you will be able to join integration activities and other crazy social events. However, you will always be part of the SCOPE family!

CURRENTLY OPEN COMMITTEE POSITIONS

In this brochure, you will find an overview of all the currently open committees within our 4 pillars. Next to the committee name, we state the amount of actives the committee is currently recruiting. Finally, the average workload is indicated as an estimate for you to have a better idea of which committees are more demanding than others. Yet, these estimates are subjective and depend on the period and on the person. If you have any questions, do not hesitate to ask a board member.

ACADEMIC PILLAR

Academic Lectures - 2 actives

As member of the Academic Lectures committee, you will organise several interactive and insightful academic events throughout the year for all students. In the lectures organised by this committee, multiple speakers will combine their knowledge of a topic to create a vibrant and interesting event, where people can share their viewpoints. By being part of this committee, you are responsible for choosing the topic, finding the speakers, and the overall tone of the event.

Estimated average workload: 3-4 hours/week

Academic Workshops - 2 actives

A very important component of SCOPE is the offering of its academic activities such as extensive trainings and workshops. By becoming part of this committee, you will have a lot of freedom to come up with ideas for the structure, the themes and the kind of academic events offered, which range from debates to trainings and panel discussions.

Estimated average workload: 3-4 hours/week

Symposium - 4 actives

The SCOPE Symposium is one the largest academic events throughout the whole year. It brings together big speakers from big companies to talk about economical and societal issues that are affecting all of us. Become a part of the team that will host a day packed with fascinating viewpoints, heated discussions, and knowledge from some of the most successful people in our field. You will have the opportunity to come up with the topic, arrange the location you see as perfect fit, acquire the speakers and ideas for the marketing of the event.

Estimated average workload: 2-3 hours/week



Community Case Challenge - 1 active

The Community Case Challenge is a 2-month long event (period 4) where selected students help local companies solve a challenge they are currently facing. The event is based on a coaching experience, both academically and professionally. You will be responsible for the selection of students (based on their academic background). Moreover, you will also be in charge of operational tasks such as organising the kick-off event and final dinner, and ensuring ensure the case challenge is running smoothly. You will be in direct contact with the participating companies and coaches as well. Finally, as the CCC is a brand new SCOPE event the marketing aspect will be of crucial importance. Join the committee now and broaden your academic perspective and professional network!

Estimated average workload: 2-3 hours/week

CAREER PILLAR

Start-Up Tour Berlin - 4 actives

The Start-Up Tour introduces you to multiple highly successful start-ups in the entrepreneurship capital of Europe, Berlin! You will have the opportunity to witness the story behind different start-ups and their path to failure and success. Next to that you will also get a sneak peek into the capital provision side by engaging with venture capitalists during an exclusive event. Do you think you have what it takes to find the high-potential start-ups, to guide students through a flourishing city and work together with your fellow team members to make this trip a success? Then don't hesitate and sign up for this committee!

Estimated average workload: 3 hours/week

Stockholm Innovation & Leadership Trip - 4 actives

This brand-new trip within the career portfolio will give you an insight into the Nordics! More specifically, we will have a look at the driver of the highly developed, export-oriented Swedish economy, its vast territory and small population, and their effect on the numerous inventions and innovations created within its borders. Lastly, this trip will show students the Nordic leadership style, which is built upon a strong meeting culture, largely due to the well-rooted tradition of gaining consensus before decisions are made. The committee will ensure that the operations, alumni relations, marketing, and external relations will run smoothly. Make sure to join us on this new adventure to the beautiful city of Stockholm!

Estimated average workload: 3-4 hours/week



Maastricht Business Days Autumn - 6 actives

The Maastricht Business Days is SCOPE's most prestigious, challenging and rewarding committee. For the past 25 years, the MBDs have taken place traditionally in March. Estimated average workload: 3-4 hours/week

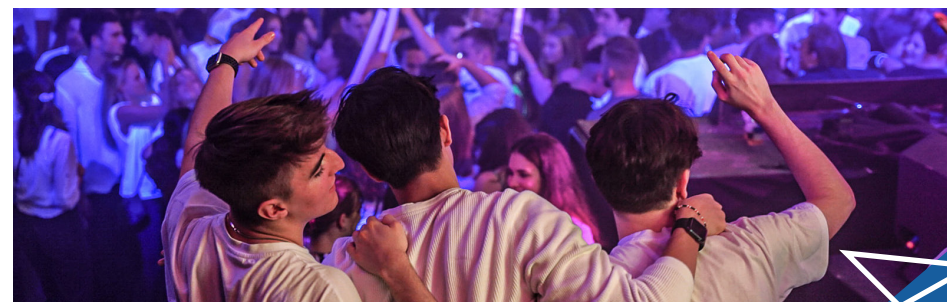


SOCIAL PILLAR

Come up with crazy ideas such as walking shots, fun parties or a running dinner, organize Active Member Weekend and create evenings you will never forget. Estimated average workload: 1-2 hours/week
